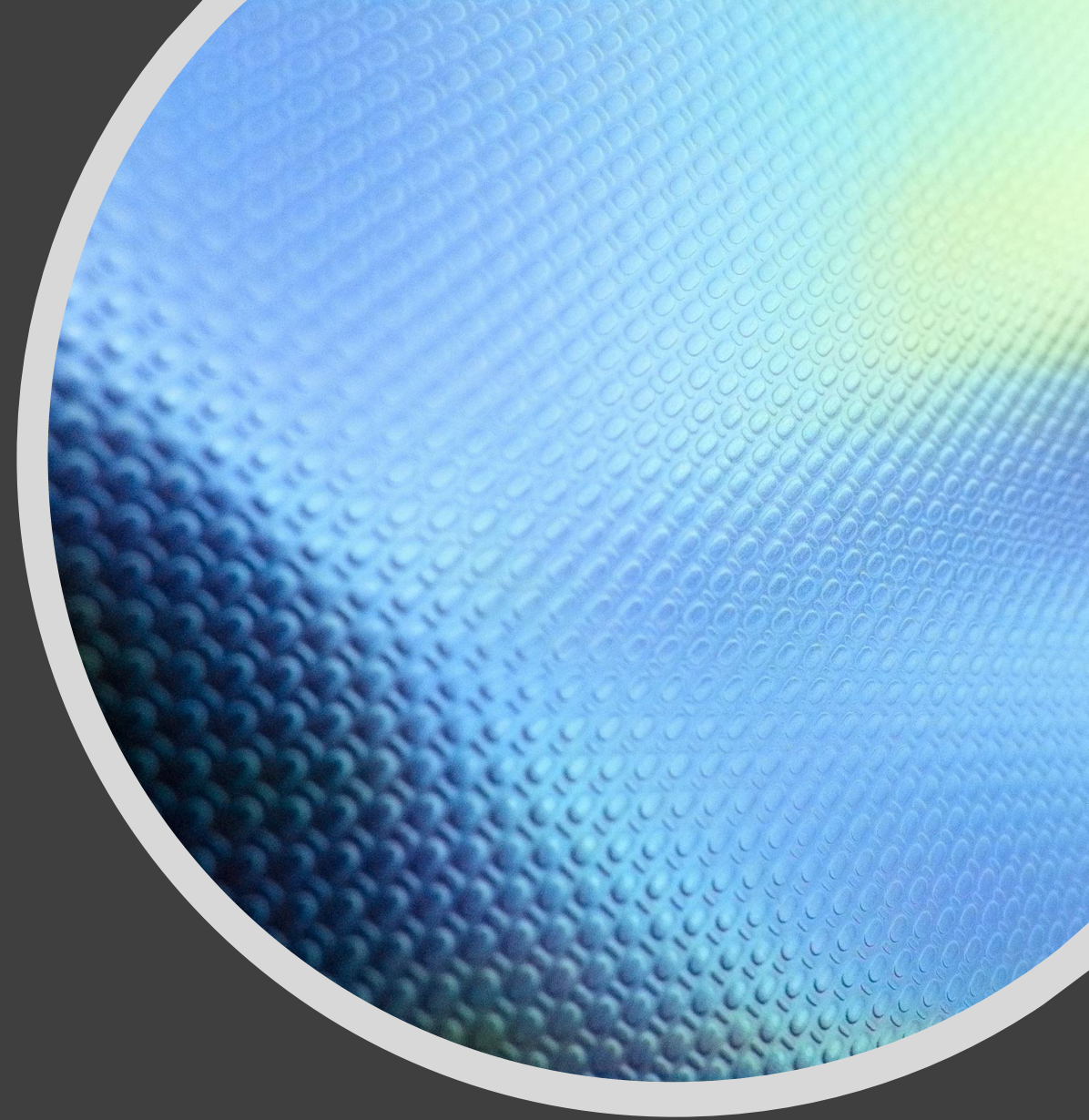

Community Life Engagement

People with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) accessing and participating in their communities outside of employment as part of a meaningful day



Community Life Engagement...

- *Leads to employment* through career exploration & networking
- *Wraps around employment* to fill gaps in time, experience, social connection
- *Supports people in retirement* in integrated ways

Community Life Engagement & COVID: Four Guideposts

1. Individualize supports for each person
2. Promote community membership and contribution
3. Use human and social capital to decrease dependence on paid supports
4. Ensure that supports are outcome-oriented and regularly monitored






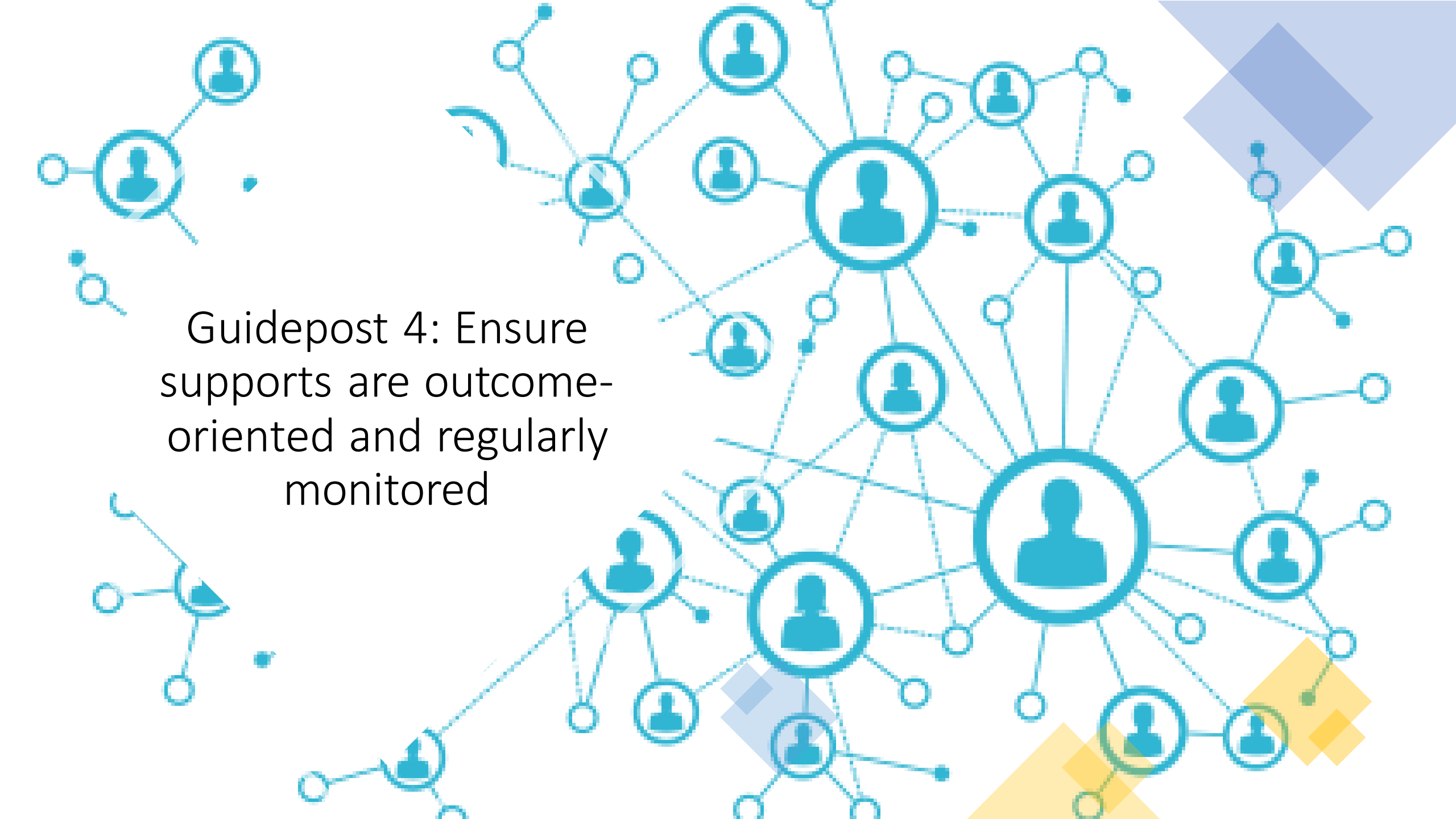
Guidepost 1: Individualize supports for each person

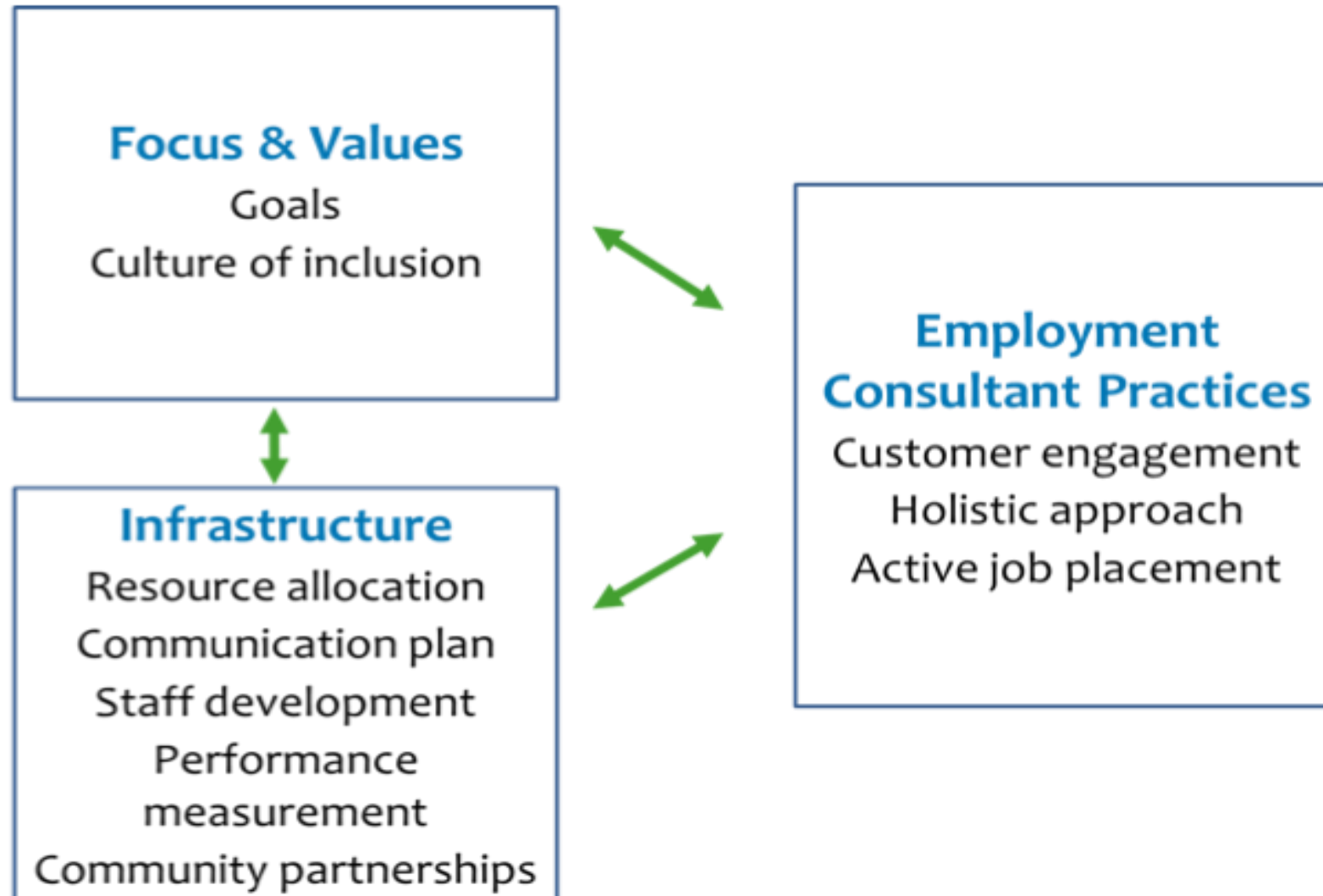
Goals
